Remember to clean out your beds of excess leaves and debris, for this could be a nice haven for unwanted rodents. While doing this, you may want to cut back any perennials that have died back. You may leave your ornamental grasses for winter interest, however; do not forget to cut them back in the early spring before they begin to grow. Applying an organic fertilizer such as Holly-Tone, Plant-tone, Flower-Tone etc., late in the season or over the winter will also help your plants receive a great start in the spring.

The farmer's fields are harvested and the grass is not as green as it used to be. So, if you are in Deer County, do not forget to start putting your netting up or keep an eye out for damage in order to spray.
